## The Pennsylvania Civil War Trails: Prelude to Gettysburg

This is more than a roadtrip, it's a journey that connects you to the Civil War in a whole new way. From battlefields and museums to story signs and living history interpreters, this is not merely a deeper look at Lincoln, Lee and Custer, but a journey to the margins.

### Rules

*Must be 18 years of age. The passport must have the required number of stamps to be eligible for gifts and the grand prize drawings.*

**Stories. Memories. Prizes.** You'll go home with all three if you're able to collect enough Passport stamps on your journey. Along the way, look for our roadside Kepi signs that help you follow the trails and discover forty story stops, heritage sites, and quaint Dutch Country communities. Collect your stamps and visit a local visitor's center (locations listed on page 9) to enter to win a grand prize.

**Collect 8 stamps – Win a Civil War Trails Pennant**

- trail guide

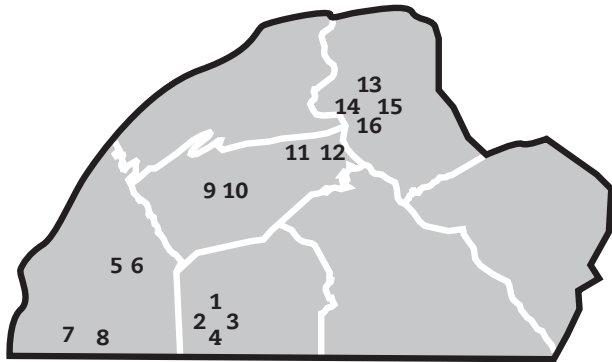

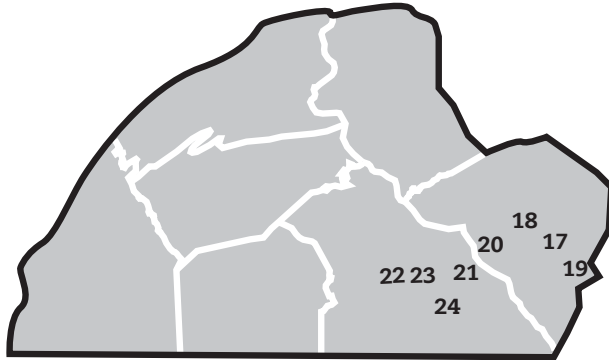
